Paster's Ponderings

What is the mission or purpose of the church? This is a question being asked by many in the wake of the events of this pandemic. This is a question every follower of Jesus Christ should be thinking about. Cameron Harder offers the following historical survey in his book, *Discovering the Other*:

Constantine's goal was to erect a church building in every town. Missionaries sought to translate the Bible into every language, to baptize the masses, or to bring Christian "civilization" to the "heathen." Modern church growth fans want to fill every pew. Contemporary liturgists seek transcendent or contextually relevant worship services. And many congregants are satisfied as long as the church hangs around to baptize, marry, and bury them, and provide a bit of pastoral care and inspiration in between."

I would like to challenge us to consider the mission of the church to be listening; listening to the stories of God; listening to the stories of people around us; listening to how the Spirit is connecting those stories together. Each time you feel compelled to tell someone or to defend what we believe to be right and true and worthy, pause and make sure you have first fully and truly invested yourself into listening to the other. After that pause, prayerfully consider if anything you have to say will honor the Apostle Paul's prayer that we might "live together in a manner worthy of Christ's gospel" (Phil 1:27).



You might watch it little later on via YouTube. It might change from week to week and that is okay – do what is best for you. We want to share in worship with you, no matter how we all join in.

(There have been reports of malicious activity like this called "zoom-bombing" which is why we use passwords and don't publish the meeting info on the web or social media.) Anyone who joins the meeting early can unmute themselves and share joys, concerns, or whatever's going on. All are welcome to hang out after worship for "coffee hour" fellowship.

Please, respect the privacy of others by not sharing info without their permission.

A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)

- 1. Dial the phone number **1-312-626-6799**
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: <u>856 2368 3669</u>
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: **8353922**
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions (whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)
 - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing *6 during the meeting
 - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing *9

B) To join the worship service with your computer or smartphone:
