Paster's Ponderings...

"What is your only comfort, in life and in death?" This is the first question of the Heildelberg Catechism. The word "comfort" was translated from the German word trost, referring to our confidence. The answer, simply put, is Jesus Christ. One of the authors of the catechism (Ursinus) noted this trost includes "the assurance of the free remission of sin. and of reconciliation with God by and on account of Christ, and a certain expectation of eternal life; impressed upon the heart by the Holy Spirit through the gospel, so that we have no doubt but that we are saved forever, according to the declaration of the apostle Paul: Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?" Many find their confidence in possessions, control, management, or mastery of some skill, topic, or action. Lesslie Newbigin in his 1995 book Proper Confidence gives an extensive argument for rooting our confidence in the Christian story, and specifically in our relationship with Jesus Christ and one another. As we look forward with hopeful joy to living and worshipping after the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, I will be continuously offering caution about "getting back to normal" and encouraging us to cultivate a healthier "new normal" for our faith life together.

WELCOME TO WORSHIP AT 8:30 A.M. EACH SUNDAY!

Your Session has just voted to update our in person meeting guidelines based on the CDC's most recent recommendations. We will continue to welcome mask usage at any time, but are not requiring masks if you are fully vaccinated. We ask that everyone continue to honor social distancing for family groups as much as is possible. We want to continue to living out the Biblical command to live with respect for all, and expect all inside our building to honor those who prefer mask usage or extra distance in their presence. Hand sanitizer and masks will continue to be available. Additionally, we will be opening the sanctuary windows and running the air exchanger to bring in fresh filtered air during worship, so please dress as if you were worshipping outside. For those who choose to gather online, will will continue the live Zoom connection as it has been (details on the next page.) After June 20th we will no longer be live streaming the service on our Facebook page. If this presents a problem for you, please let us know. Our goal is to gather together as the Body of Christ in worship.

Please remember, your Session may, at its discretion, revise or adjust these procedures as they see the need based on public health guidance and the situation of our local context. Remember Church is not where you are, but who we are together. Please join us to share in worship.

Please, respect the privacy of others by not sharing info without their permission.

A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)

- 1. Dial the phone number 1-312-626-6799
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: <u>856 2368 3669</u>
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: 8353922
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions (whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)
 - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing *6 during the meeting
 - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing *9

B) To join the worship service with your computer or smartphone:

- 1. Download the Zoom App
- 2. Join the Zoom Meeting by one of the following options:
