## Paster's Ponderings ....

Why do we gather? This is a question posed in the opening chapter of "The Art of Gathering" by Priya Parker, and one of the many questions we need to be asking ourselves as we cultivate the "new normal" as we gather together after the COVID pandemic. Why do we gather on Sunday mornings at 8:30/10:30AM for worship? The answers may seem straight-forward and simple at first, but I want us to think deeper. Why on Sunday? Why at 8:30/10:30AM or any other time? Why at church in the Sanctuary? Why do we structure our worship service as we do? Why do we include or exclude the call to worship, prayer of confession and words of assurance, affirmation of faith, etc.? What is the meaning and purpose of including or excluding scripture readings from various portions of the Bible (Old Testament, Psalms, Epistles, Gospel) and how does that impact our overall understanding of scripture? What is the difference between hearing a sermon preached from a raised pulpit or from the same level as everyone in the pews? As we become more aware of and name the deeper influences of our own various answers, we need to honestly and openly ask questions to those who aren't gathering with us. Questions such as: Why don't you gather with us or even like we do? How might we need to change our gatherings to be more meaningful to believers for the years ahead? How might we need to better explain why we aren't willing to change some aspects of our gathering, and why that element of worship is important and deeply meaningful to our faith development?

Why do we gather? I invite us all to come re-experience worship together in the sanctuary on Sunday morning as we all reflect and offer our insights to these and many more questions.

### A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)

- 1. Dial the phone number 1-312-626-6799
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: <u>856 2368 3669</u>
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: 8353922
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions (whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)
  - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing \*6 during the meeting
  - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing \*9

### WELCOME TO WORSHIP AT 8:30 A.M. EACH SUNDAY!

Your Session has just voted to update our in person meeting guidelines based on the CDC's most recent recommendations. We will continue to welcome mask usage at any time, but are not requiring masks if you are fully vaccinated. We ask that everyone continue to honor social distancing for family groups as much as is possible. We want to continue to living out the Biblical command to live with respect for all, and expect all inside our building to honor those who prefer mask usage or extra distance in their presence. Hand sanitizer and masks will continue to be available. Additionally, we will be opening the sanctuary windows and running the air exchanger to bring in fresh filtered air during worship, so please dress as if you were worshipping outside. For those who choose to gather online, will will continue the live Zoom connection as it has been (details on the next page.) After June 20<sup>th</sup> we will no longer be live streaming the service on our Facebook page. If this presents a problem for you, please let us know. Our goal is to gather together as the Body of Christ in worship.

Please remember, your Session may, at its discretion, revise or adjust these procedures as they see the need based on public health guidance and the situation of our local context. Remember Church is not where you are, but who we are together. Please join us to share in worship.
