Paster's Ponderings

"Holy Week" is April 10-17.

As we come to the end of our journey "Walking through Lent" we should take time to "recalibrate" our spiritual compass to guide us to live out the meaning of the empty cross. As we journey through Holy Week, our emotions go from enthusiasm to solemnity, to grief and betrayal, to confusion, and back to enthusiasm again. The difference between the two bookend emotions of enthusiasm is that the first is based on our expectations of what is to come, and the second is based on what God did unexpectedly. May we continue to wake up to the unexpected wonders of our God!

We begin the week with Palm Sunday. This gets its name from the people waving palm branches as Jesus entered Jerusalem. While waving the palms, they shouted "Hosanna!" which means "Lord, save us! We beg you to save us." (These are the same voices that later in the week will also shout, "Crucify Him!")

Maundy Thursday is our reminder of the "new commandment" Jesus gave his disciples to love one another as he has loved them. We get the word "maundy" from the Latin *mandatum* – mandate, or commandment.

Good Friday is our reminder of Jesus' trial before Pilate, his torture, crucifixion, and burial. This does not equate with "good" as we know it, but rather through the now obsolete sense of the word "good" meaning holy.

Easter Sunday gets its name from... well, we don't actually know for sure! Most attribute it to either the appropriation of the pagan goddess of spring or a transliteration of the German translation of the Latin for "dawn" – as a reminder that the tomb was found empty at dawn on the third day.

A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)

- 1. Dial the phone number *-***-***
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: ********
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: ******
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions (whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)
 - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing *6 during the meeting
 - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing *9

B) To join the worship service with your <u>computer</u> or <u>smartphone</u>:

- 1. Download the Zoom App
- 2. Join the Zoom Meeting by one of the following options:
