Paster's Ponderings

Shane Claiborne writes the following in *Common Prayer: A Liturgy for Ordinary Radicals:* "Much of our theology has been so concentrated on heaven that it invalidates any concern for the earth. Some images in Scripture have even been misconstrued to perpetuate a disregard for the creation, such as the image that in the last days the world will be consumed by fire. But nearly every other time the 'consumed by fire' image is evoked in Scripture, it is a fire that purifies rather than burns up, a fire that frees up life rather than destroys it. No doubt, the way we live is shaped by how we imagine the end of the world — whether we think God's final plan is for everything to go up in flames or for everything to be brought back to life."

As we celebrate the end of another school year and continue to "get back to normal" in various ways, may we be open and receptive to the Spirit's leading. This may very well mean that we do not "get back to normal" as we might expect, but rather join God as new life is being brought into the voids created by the pandemic.

A great way to do this is by cultivating healthy spiritual habits. I strongly encourage you to consider the practice of Daily Prayer as Shane and others have re-visioned it. A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)

- 1. Dial the phone number 1-312-626-6799
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: xxxxxxxxxx
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: xxxxxx
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions *(whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)*
 - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing ***6** during the meeting
 - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing *9

B) To join the worship service with your <u>computer</u> or <u>smartphone</u>:

- 1. Download the Zoom App
- 2. Join the Zoom Meeting by one of the following options:
