#### PASTOR'S PONDERINGS FOR THE NEW YEAR: Who Am I? Who Are We?

As we transition through the end of another year into the beginning of 2023, I encourage us all to pause and reflect on our lives – our lives as unique persons; our lives connected with others; our lives as a community; our lives as a family of faith; our lives as part of the Church universal. What impact does our identity as part of the Church universal have on the perception of our personal identity? Much more than most of us realize. Too many people, including those who profess having a Christian faith, view their personal identity through a lens that has little or nothing to do with who they are as a child of God. As we begin a new year, I encourage us all to pause and reflect on our identity as God's children, followers of Jesus Christ, and members of the Body of Christ, the Church universal. If we make time to start each day being reminded by scripture of who we are in God's eyes, we will soon see ourselves thinking and acting differently, and soon others will see a difference in us, and hopefully, the Holy Spirit will lead them to see their lives and purposes in a new light. Here are some scriptures to get you started on a 50-Day Identity Challenge. Each day, read the scripture verse (and possibly the surrounding context), write down a quality of our Biblical identity described, how you might better live out that quality, and how you might use that quality in service to your family of faith and the Body of Christ. As you go through this list, look back to see what qualities you are retaining, and what qualities are harder to live out. This will be most effective if you find a few other people to do this with, encouraging one another as you grow.

## A) To join the worship service with your phone audio only:

(This will work with any landline, flip phone, or smart phone)


- 1. Dial the phone number 1-312-626-6799
- 2. Enter the Meeting ID: xxxxxxxxxx
- 3. You will be asked to enter another code OR press # again: ONLY PRESS #
- 4. Enter the password: xxxxxxx
- 5. You will automatically be muted to prevent feedback and distractions (whenever a noise is detected, the visual screen switches to that participant)
  - a. You can mute or unmute yourself by pressing \*6 during the meeting
  - b. You can "raise your hand" to let us know you want to talk by pressing \*9

# B) To join the worship service with your computer or smartphone:

- 1. Download the Zoom App
- 2. Join the Zoom Meeting by one of the following options:
  - a. Use this link:
