
The Pantry served the following July 5, 2023

Recipe Corner

This month's recipe is from Amy Peterson's Great-Grandmother, Mary Hintz. It is appropriate as we enter zucchini harvest season:

Zucchini Bread Makes 2 loaves

- 3 eggs
- 1 cup oil
- 2 cups sugar
- 3 tsps vanilla
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 3/4 tsp nutmeg
- 3 tsps cinnamon
- 3 cups flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp baking powder

Mix all ingredients in large mixing bowl. Add 2 cups grated zucchini. Spray both bread loaf pans with cooking spray or butter. Spread mixture evenly between 2 bread pans. Bake at 325 degrees for 55 minutes. When a toothpick comes out clean from center, they are done. Tastes best slightly warm with butter.
