#### **Chicken Broccoli Casserole**

1 bunch of broccoli/2 ½ bags of frozen broccoli, cut up, cooked and place on bottom of casserole dish 1 chicken(I used several breasts, cooked, skinned, and boned(save 2 C. of the broth)

Layer bite-size pieces of chicken over broccoli in casserole. Add 1 can cream of chicken soup, undiluted, over the above(may use 2 cans, depending on the amount).

1 pkg. Stove Top dressing

Sprinkle packet of dry seasoning on top of cream soup layer. Then add the bread cubes on top of seasoning. Next pour 2 C. of chicken broth over all. Bake at 350 degrees until bubbly, about 1 hour or so.

Taking another stroll down memory lane, here is one recipe taken from 1929 Presbyterian Ladies Auxiliary.

#### **Graham Cracker Cake**

1/2 C. butter 1 C. sugar

2 Eggs 1 C. Sweet milk (scant) 28 graham crackers rolled twice and sifted 2 tsp. baking powder

1/2 C. nuts, chopped fine 1/2 tsp. salt

1 Tbsp. flour

Cream butter and sugar. Beat eggs separately. Add milk and cracker crumbs to creamed butter and sugar. Then velks of eggs, beling powder selt, flour, and puts. Fold in beaten egg whites lest

Then yolks of eggs, baking powder, salt, flour, and nuts. Fold in beaten egg whites last.
