Ham & Cheese Sliders

1 pkg King's Hawaiian slider buns (12 ct)

12 slices black forest ham

6 slices Harvarti cheese

4 Tbs. salted butter melted

1 tsp. Dijon mustard

1/4 tsp. Worchestershire sauce

1/4 tsp. Onion powder

- Place the bottom of the slider buns into a greased 9x13 pan.
- Layer the ham on the top of the buns, followed by the cheese slices.
- 3. Place the top of the buns over the top.
- Mix melted butter, Dijon, Worchestershire and onion power.
- Brush on top of the rolls.
- Loosely cover with foil and bake at 350 degrees for 15 min.
