Worship committee:

Kit Kat Bars

Club crackers

1 c. salted butter

1 c. packed brown sugar

½ c. sugar

2 c. graham cracker crumbs

½ c. milk

3/3 c. creamy peanut butter

1/2 c. butterscotch chips

1/2 c. chocolate chips

- Line ungreased 9x13 pan with a layer of club crackers.
- In large saucepan, over low to medium heat, melt butter and both sugars gently - while stirring.
- Stir in graham crumbs and milk. Stir well until all is melted and combined (do not allow mixture to boil.
- Remove from heat and carefully spread half of the mixture evenly over crackers. Spread it out as evenly as possible.
- 5. Layer with another layer of crackers followed by the mixture.
- Place a final layer of crackers on top.
- In a small saucepan, combine peanut butter and chips. Melt over low to medium heat, stirring occasionally until completely melted and blended.
- 8. Spread evenly over the top layer of crackers.
- 9. Place in fridge for an hour or two for the chocolate layer to set.
