Highlight of the Month

Your Clerk of Session,

As it states in the Clerk of Session Handbook for Winnebago Presbytery....."Welcome to the office of Clerk of Session! You have joined a unique and important group of people in the Presbyterian Church (USA). The Book of Order mandates that each governing body of the PC (USA) has a moderator and a clerk. Clerks of presbyteries, synods and the General Assembly are called stated clerks. Those serving Sessions are called clerks of Session. A Session clerk is a ruling elder who may or may not be currently serving as an active elder elected by the congregation. As clerk, you will record a good deal of the history of your church as you write the session minutes and maintain all church records."

General Role and Requirements are....

- Maintain and preserve the minutes, rolls and registers of our congregation, including Session Meeting Minutes,
 Congregational Meeting Minutes, Deacons Minutes, Baptized Members Roll, Active Members Roll, Affiliate Members
 Roll, Inactive Members Roll, Installed Pastor Register, Elder Register, Deacon Register, Baptism Register, Marriage
 Register. Also be very familiar with the Book of Order, know Robert's Rules, send and receive communications on behalf
 of session, assist the pastor regarding matters related to session.
- 2. The Clerk of Session is also responsible for the following reports to Presbytery and the General Assembly: Annual Session Minutes Review of previous year's minutes and attend the Annual Clerks Record Review, Annual Necrology Report, Annual Statistical Report, Clerk's Annual Questionnaire, Newsletter articles, assisting the moderator in keeping track of reports and motions for the agenda, keeper of the church's Bylaws and manuals, assist the moderator with putting together an agenda for Session meetings, recording all the requirements needed for good minutes as provided in the Clerks Handbook and from the Stated Clerk from Winnebago Presbytery.
- Please note, some of the above items are shared as directed by the clerk to Stacy Office Staff and to Nikki Giese, who is the Session Recorder.
- 4. Latest duties added on December 17, 2023 Session Meeting with Pastor Craig Alwin and Rev. David Colby Winnebago Presbytery Commission on Ministry Representative guiding us through the process with the resignation of Rev. Dr. Craig Alwin, effective 12/31/23. As Clerk of Session, received all copies of all documents pertaining to this process and the dissolution of pastoral relationships are filed and maintained in Session records, clerk is the key contact person with David Colby - Winnebago Presbytery, and clerk of Session will seek all pulpit supply from a list provided from Presbytery. Clerk is also to report to the congregation on the Pastor Search process and Session meeting updates along with announcements on Sunday mornings.

Notes from your Clerk of Session: Session met on Sunday evening October 20th with David Colby, Transitional General Presbyter from Winnebago Presbytery. Together we covered church business as usual and continued discussions on our transition journey. This is a slow-going process, but steps are being made as we proceed forward getting closer to completing our Church Leadership Connection Form for the pastor search. We have been focusing on the criteria of what we are looking for in a part time pastor as we chart our path forward. Sometime in the months ahead, we will be ready to take the next big step of electing a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC), so please, prayerfully consider serving on the PNC when we get to that next step on this path. We have the calendar filled for each Sunday with great leaders and Pastors as our Pastor Supply. Each month, we take a serious look at our financial situation, which we continue to struggle with and is the main reason for searching for a part time pastor. Our expenses are greater than our income each month, membership attendance has been low but slowly picking up and unpaid per capita took a big chunk out of our budget, which that money could have been used for our daily operating expenses. If you have not paid your per capita of \$38 per member for 2024, we would greatly appreciate your commitment as member of this church family.

Garlic Bread Meatball Bombs

- 12 dinner rolls
- 12 meatballs cooked
- 2 c. mozzarella cheese shredded
- 1 tsp. Italian seasoning
- 1/2 c. salted butter
- 3 garlic cloves minced
- 2 Tb. parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp. Dried parsley
- 1/2 tsp. Dried oregano Marinara or spaghetti sauce
- Cook meatballs according to recipe or pre-packaged directions
- In a small saucepan, melt butter and add garlic. Cook over medium heat until butter and garlic just start turning brown. Remove from heat and set aside.
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Spray 9x13 baking pan with cooking spray. Line with dinner rolls.
- Hollow out the top of each roll, making a hole large enough to fit a meatball. Make sure to not cut completely through the bottom of the roll.
- Whisk parmesan, oregano, and italian seasoning into butter mixture. Using a pastry brush, liberally smother the inside of each roll.
- Spoon a Tb. of marinara or spaghetti sauce into each roll. Place meatball into each roll and top with more sauce.
- Sprinkle mozzarella cheese on top of each roll.
- Bake for 10-12 minutes.
