Sweet chili meatballs

- 1 lb ground beef or turkey
- 1 large egg
- ¼-½ c. seasoned breadcrumbs or Panko crumbs
- ¼ c. grated parmesan cheese
- 1 Tb. olive oil
- 1 Tb. dried parsley
- Chili sauce

- ½ c. chili sauce
- 1/4 c. apricot preserves
- Preheat airfryer to 400 degrees F.
- Add all meatball ingredients into a mixing bowl and mix well.
- Scoop rounded tablespoon of mix and form into meatballs.
- Spray the air fryer with non-stick cooking spray and place the meatballs in a single layer about 1" apart.
- 5. Cook for 7-10 min, shaking the basket halfway through.
- 6. In a small mixing bowl, combine chili sauce ingredients and mix well.
- Transfer cooked meatballs into large mixing bowl, pour the chili sauce over the top, toss meatballs to coat them evenly.
- 8. Serve with rice and steamed broccoli.
