We are pleased to announce that we are making progress in our search for a Temporary part-time pastor. The Transition Team has come up with the following job description that has been approved by Session and will be posted very soon.

First Presbyterian Church of Oconto, WI, is looking for a temporary pastor, called by God to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ and to minister to the needs of our congregation of slightly under 100 confirmed members, pursuant to the teaching of the Holy Bible.

This position will be 18-20 hours a week for 2 weeks per month. The responsibilities will include, but not limited to, leading worship, helping with Christian Education, preaching two Sundays monthly, developing relationships with the congregation, and overseeing office duties related to the operations of First Presbyterian Church.

This position will be reviewed annually. Hiring is subject to a personal interview process and background records check.

Session:




Worship committee:
