

Recipe Corner

Seasoned Pretzels

1 lb. bag Pretzels

1/4 C. canola oil

2 tsp. dry ranch dressing

1 tsp. dill weed

½ tsp. garlic powder (or to taste)

Combine oil and seasonings in a small bowl. Put pretzels in a gallon size zip lock bag. Pour seasoned oil over pretzels. Seal bag and gently shake so as not to break pretzels and evenly distribute oil. Pour them on a jelly roll pan. Bake at 325 degrees for 12-13 minutes, stirring once. Watch carefully. Cool on rack and serve!
