Per Capita 2026 - \$40.42 Per Member

What is Per Capita? In Essence: Per Capita is a set amount of money (apportionment) per member that congregations pay to the larger Presbyterian Church (USA). Said in another way, it is a Presbyterian Covenant Community Fund – part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. It connects Presbyterian congregation and mid councils with the work of the wider church. Per Capita is how Presbyterians mutually and equitably share the cost of moving the church forward into the 21st century.

HIGHLIGHT OF THE MONTH

Greg Braatz A big hello to members and friends of First Presbyterian of Oconto!

I asked for the opportunity to introduce myself to you even before we begin our ministry together. As you may have read in the church newsletter, your session has hired me to be your quarter-time pastor starting January 1, 2026, and I couldn't be more excited!

So, what does it mean to be a quarter-time pastor? Particularly, a quarter-time pastor who will continue to live in Appleton. The most visible part is that I will be leading worship two times per month. Generally, the first and third Sundays, but that may vary slightly depending on my schedule. Also, I will have two in-person administration days, generally the Wednesday before the Sunday I lead worship. I will basically be helping with all that behind-the-scenes stuff that it takes to run a church and attend committee meetings. I will also be available for hospital visits as needed.

On these admin days I would also like to get to know you as individuals. I would love it if you would stop by and chat. Or let's set a time to meet somewhere for a cup of coffee! I'm anxious to get to know all of you better! Keep an eye on the church newsletter to see when I will be in town. If I'm not in town, I'm available via zoom.

So, a little about me personally. I grew up in Minnesota. Attended Luther College, in Decorah, Iowa, and got a degree in Politics. Along the way I also attended the University of Nottingham, England (and yes, I did meet the sheriff). Got my MBA from the University of Minnesota in Marketing. My certification to be a Commissioned Ruling Elder from Dubuque Theological Seminary.

After getting my MBA, I accepted a position at Kimberly-Clark, where I worked for 30 years. I held a variety of jobs in marketing and sales support. Corn Spoon Bread

2 eggs	1 C. sour cream (or Greek yogurt)
1/2 stick of butter	8 oz. whole kernel corn
8 oz. creamed corn	1 box Jiffy Corn muffin mix

Mix it all together. Bake at 350 degrees for 35-45 minutes. I like to add green chiles to the mixture.
